And the sight of a star-filled sky and dancing northern lights **on a crisp winter's night.**

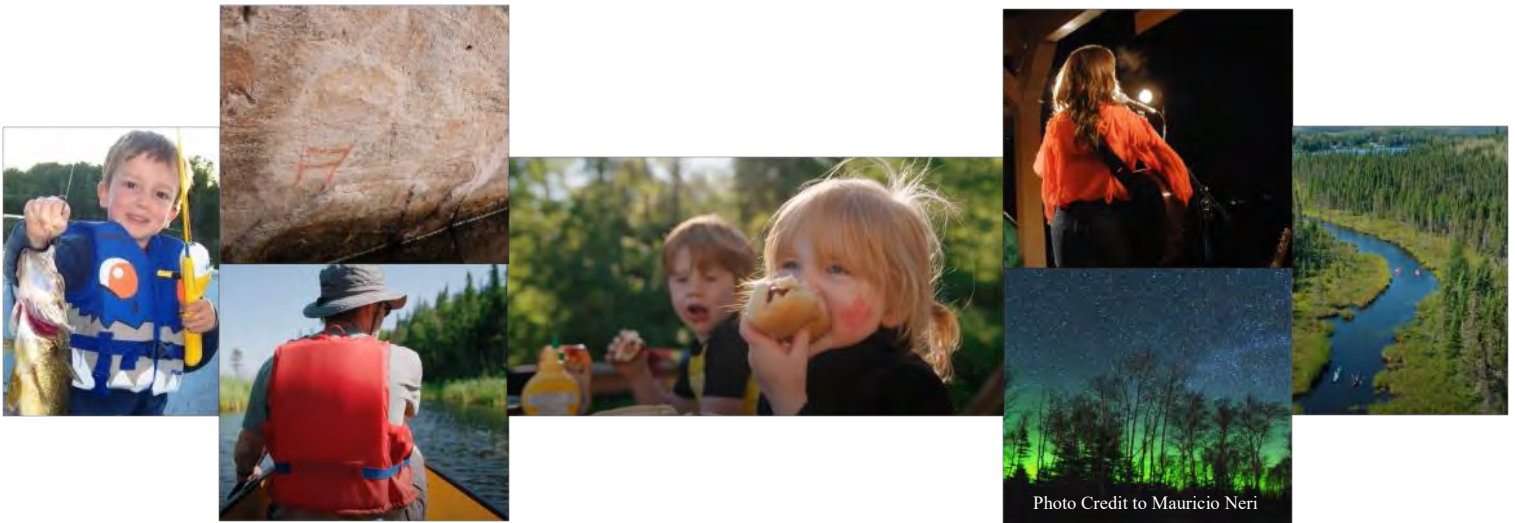

In 1925 on July 25th the Howey Brothers discover gold.

In 1936, Howey Bay was the busiest airport in the world;

From 1930 to present there have been 26 different mine sites developed in the area.
New areas continue to be explored.

Evolution Mining Red Lake Operation is one of the Canada's leading gold producers;

If you drive as far north as you can travel on
Ontario's Provincial Highway System, you will find yourself
at the ferry dock in Cochenour;

Red Lake is the Norseman Floatplane capital of the world;

There have been two Hudson's Bay Posts in the area:
one from 1825 to 1925 at Post Narrows, and
one from 1925 to 1933 at Johnson's Point.

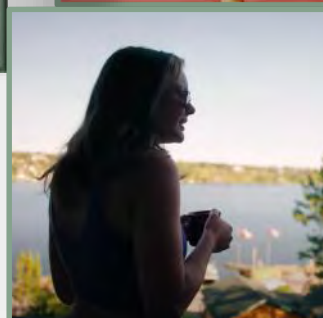
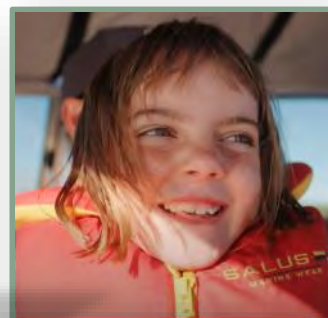
Where can I buy a specialty coffee? The Water Buffalo is located at #6 Highway 105 and serves a large variety of specialty coffees and teas.
